Position Summary

The Aquatic Supervisor works directly for the Activity Supervisor. They shall primarily be responsible for the supervision of all waterfront activities and staff; enforces all waterfront safety rules; maintains and organizes all waterfront equipment; and assists in the operations of the Roasted Walnut.

Key Job Functions

Aquatic Supervision

- Execute proper training for all lifeguards prior to summer.
- Supervises all staff assigned to support all waterfront activities.
- Enforces all rules pertaining to the waterfront activities for maximum safety.
- Maintains waterfront equipment including boats, canoes, oars, paddles, life jackets and all safety
 equipment. The safety equipment includes a bull horn, an assist pole, a ring buoy or throw bag, a
 backboard, and a first-aid kit.
- Be an innovative problem solver seeking to improve the waterfront offerings of Pine Ridge.
- Present at the waterfront at all times when any waterfront activity is taking place.

Other Duties

- Assists with the Roasted Walnut evening operations.
- Assists in other areas of the camp as available including game times, camper check-out and other assignments from the Activity Supervisor.
- A summer staff member in a small organization like Pine Ridge is often called upon to perform a
 wide variety of duties. This may include many of the following duties (not an exhaustive list):
 - Assisting with maintenance duties like repairs, construction, landscaping, and lawn care.
 - Assisting with housekeeping duties like cleaning, sweeping, and mopping.
 - Assisting with kitchen duties like dish washing, and food preparation
 - Assisting with cabin duties like cabin leading, free time monitoring, and spiritual direction.

Sample Schedule

8:00am- Breakfast 5:00pm- Dinner 9:00am- Get set up for the day/time off 6:00pm- Chapel

10:30am- Supervise Waterfront until Lunch 7:00pm- Assist in Roasted Walnut

12:00pm- Lunch 9:30pm- Help with evening events as directed

1:15pm- Supervise Waterfront until Dinner by the Activity Supervisor

General Qualifications

- Agrees with the philosophies, policies, and procedures of Pine Ridge Bible Camp.
- Has a sincere love for the Lord and a desire to see campers come to know and grow in Him.
- Is willing to forego personal rights for the common good of the camp and camper.
- Is flexible and able to work with campers and other staff members.
- Communicates clearly both orally and in writing.
- Be in good standing with a local church.

Specific Qualifications

- Is trained and certified by American Red Cross standards for lifeguards and CPR/AED for the professional rescuers (or equivalent certifications as allowed by the State of Michigan).
- Is an adult at least 18 years old, preferably 21 years old or older.
- An adult who has proven competent abilities and experience in supervising a team.

Working Conditions and Physical Requirements

- Must be able to lift, bend, and twist.
- Ability to push and pull loads.
- Must be able to lift frequently up to 35 lbs.; occasionally 35-100 lbs. with assistance
- Good hand-eye coordination.
- Auditory ability to hear and understand conversational levels of sound in an ordinary office environment.
